Design a unique floor plate with a cultural influence into the development that is vernacular, contextual and individual.

Client 2 is a buyer of one of the units - husband, wife and child.

The Docks units pay homage to the areas rich shipping and industrial history. The materials used within The Docks units are heavily influenced by the heritage listed site of Mort Bay. In particular the use of rusted metal feature walls throughout, are a nod to Balmain's maritime past.

Careful considered spatial planning has been used in the floor plate design to maximise the number of units without compromising the comfort within each of the residences. A light well with vertical garden is positioned outside the lifts, that runs through the entire building.


The existing building was designed by Allen Jack + Cottier, however, the floor plan needed updating to suit the professional couple with no kids.



The Bellagio unit - external view




Stairs - isometric view






1 Kitchen Detail Plan







The three-storey terrace house in Paddington was transformed into a light filled, functional and comfortable home.

The stairs and the skylight are a central piece of the design and provide maximum visual and lighting impact upon entering the terrace.

Party walls in the terrace house means there are no windows on the sides of the house, which also meant there was limited natural light, especially into the basement level. A skylight, on an angle, is designed to capture the northern sun rather than harsh Western sun. It allows beautiful natural light to filter through a void located in the middle of the house which maximises the interplay of light right down to the basement level.

DESCRIPTION

The Mitchison House is an existing terrace building located in Sydney's Eastern Suburbs with a rich architectural history and heritage facade.

The project requested a full documentation set for the proposed renovation of the site. The client (home owners) desired a more open plan design.

The clients love of artworks produced by Stephen Ormandy, and his exploration of the relationship between colour and tone, has greatly influenced the selection of materials in this project. Rich colours, organic shapes (through furniture selection), with complements of gold form the basis of the design.

As a terrace, natural light is valuable and so a wide spanning, stacking glass door to access the backyard, has been integrated into the design. Bringing a luminous and refreshing feel to the space.
